Review activity

- Following approval of the review protocol and with the permission of the BEME team we submitted and were successful in publishing the protocol in the Journal of Systematic Reviews in May 2015. The paper can be downloaded at the following [link](#)
- The peer review process yielded a number of valuable suggestions for the review that have been included in a revised protocol with the approval of the BEME team
- The search strategy was independently reviewed by an information scientist not related to the review
- Aileen Barrett worked with a second information scientist on a tracking/documentation mechanism for the database searches
- The database searches are underway and a pilot test process with authors to ensure precision and accuracy of screening will be completed in June 2015
- The project is running to schedule
